

Info-day on 'Copernicus' data and services: Northern Greece event

An info-day on the European Union's Earth Observation Programme <u>`Copernicus</u>', is being organized by the BEYOND Center of Excellence of the National Observatory of Athens (NOA) in collaboration with PRAXI Network/FORTH, at the Municipal Library of Thessaloniki on the 30<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

The info-day aims to raise awareness in the Region of Northern Greece and inform the relevant players about the Copernicus EU Programme. The action aims to reach all the potential Greek recipients (intermediate or end users) of Copernicus. It aims particularly to demonstrate the emerging opportunities from using Copernicus to new groups of people, previously not aware of it but potentially very interested. Examples of uptake actions, success stories and discussions on 4 different EO thematics (Disasters, Energy, Food Security, Epidemics) will be included. Additionally, a special workshop on the 'Sustainable Agriculture' thematic will be offered to public authorities' representatives. In this workshop, the participants will learn in practical level the value and opportunities offered by Copernicus towards public services.

'Copernicus' is the European Union's Earth observation programme, looking at our planet and its environment to benefit all European citizens. It offers information services that draw from satellite Earth Observation and in-situ (non-space) data. European citizens, ranging from policy makers, researchers, commercial to private users, as well as the global scientific community can benefit in many ways from the data and information provided by Copernicus. Indeed, Copernicus supports a variety of applications in several non-space domains, which potentially impact businesses and organisations in day-to-day activities and operations.

The event is being organized in the framework of the <u>FPCUP</u> (Caroline Herschel Framework Partnership Agreement), <u>e-shape</u> (H2020) and the <u>EMPROS</u> (EPAnEK 2014-2020) Projects.
